## K. <u>INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY COMMITTEE</u> LONGWOOD COMMITTEE ON COPYRIGHTS AND PATENTS

- 1. **Purpose and Duties**: <u>This committee convenes as requested by the Provost and Vice</u> <u>President for Academic Affairs (PVPAA) to review and make recommendations</u> <u>regarding cases involving intellectual property issues. The responsibility of this committee</u> <u>is to review issues, questions, or disputes pertaining to ownership of intellectual property</u> <u>rights involving possible ownership, or partial ownership, by the University, and to</u> <u>interpret the Intellectual Property Policy with respect to those issues</u>. (See Section II,S.)
- 2. Membership: 5 faculty members.
- 3. **Ex-Officio Members**: (non-voting): Director of the Office of Sponsored Programs, <u>and</u> Dean of the Library. <u>Vice President for Administration and Finance</u>, and a designee from <u>University Marketing and Communications</u>.
- 4. Restrictions: None
- 5. Departmental Restrictions: None
- 6. **College Restrictions**: Three faculty members from the Cook-Cole College of Arts and Sciences (one from Mathematics or the natural Sciences; one from social sciences; one from the humanities), one faculty member from the College of Business and Economics, one faculty member from the College of Education and Human Services.
- 7. Other restrictions: None
- 8. **Term of Office**: 3-year staggered terms. May be reappointed for 1 additional term with a 6-year maximum.
- 9. **Method of Selection**: Appointed by the Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs (PVPAA) (upon nomination by the Executive Committee of the Faculty Senate).
- 10. Chair: Appointed by the PVPAA.
- 11. **Reporting Route:** The PVPAA (see Section II,S).
