VII. Other Business:

- a. Syllabus: Suggestion was made to use Dr. Shoenthal's recommendation and change the Course Requirements area to: Course Requirements (assignment descriptions; for major assignments, this should also include due dates and their connections to student learning outcomes). Bill will re-do the latest version to incorporate this recommendation and will have a conversation with Core regarding consistency in wording. A suggestion was also made for the committee to pilot writing their Spring syllabi using the outlined requirements and bring feedback to the next meeting before voting to approve.
- b. Catalog Language: A "Transfer Information" area will be created in the catalog so that individual departments will not have to accommodate for the differences in requirements for transfer students vs non-transfer students. The section for transfer students will indicate that transfer students will use old General Education requirements to instead of new Core requirements to complete their degree and that additional information can be found in an appendix. Old General Education requirements will simply replace the Core requirements for other students. Transfer students still need to complete major requirements for their catalog year (not major requirements for previous years).
