Health and Human Services Task Force

- Task: evaluate competitiveness of current health and human services (HHS) programs and consider administrative structures
- Methods: EAB, Bureau of Labor Statistics, and Va. Dept. of Health Professions data;
 8 campus focus groups; 1 Zoom open forum; 5 external advisory committees

Findings:

- Health professions among fastest growing nationwide and in Virginia
- Longwood only university in Virginia with multiple health and human services programs without unique unit
- A HHS unit would enhance visibility, recruitment & retention of students (and faculty), facilitate cutting edge curricula (cross-disciplinary, interprofessional education, simulated clients)
- Unbundling of Education and Human Services in CEHS would enhance recognition of Longwood's programs in both education and human services

Next steps:

- Presentation to Enrollment Management Team, Provost, and President
- 20-21 work (potential new programs, cross-disciplinary courses, logistics)
