Policy*

A senior at Longwood University may take up to six (6) hours of graduate credit that may be counted towards the graduate degree and electives in the undergraduate degree. Such credit may be earned only in 500-level courses and, if it meets course requirements for the degree, may be counted toward a master's degree. The senior must have an overall GPA that meets the minimum GPA required for admission to the graduate program which offers offering the course and must receive permission. Permission is required from the department chair of their major, graduate program director, and then the Graduate Dean through submission of the College of Graduate and Professional Studies. Permission for Seniors must request permission using this to Take Graduate Courses form . In any case where an undergraduate student is registered for a 500-level course that is to be applied to a graduate degree, the Dean of Once approval has been confirmed by the College of Graduate and Professional Studies must notify, the Office of Registrar and the Registrar of this
