

Faculty Status and Grievances Committee Report

2023-2024

The committee did not receive any inquiries or requests for formal grievances during the 2023-2024 academic year. The members of the Faculty Status and Grievances Committee met several times throughout the year to discuss possible revisions to the language and hearing process outlined in the FPPM. A proposal was submitted to the Faculty Senate on February 8, 2024, to include a specific date (February 1) in the FPPM to begin the electoral process of the Faculty Status and Grievances Committee. The proposal was passed by the Faculty Senate on February 29, 2024. The committee submitted a second proposal to be discussed at the April 4, 2024 Faculty Senate meeting. The proposal offers revisions to the procedures of submitting a request for a hearing and the hearing process.
