Bachelor of General Studies Committee

Purposes and Duties: This committee will serve as the program committee within the Professional Studies office for the Bachelor of General Studies degree with the following responsibilities: to review and approve new concentrations proposed for the BGS; to present new concentrations or program changes to the Committee on Educational Policy; and to design and oversee a program assessment plan.

Membership: Two (2) faculty members from the CEHS, two (2) faculty members from CBE, three (3) faculty members from CAS, one (1) at large member, and the coordinator of the BGS

Ex-officio Members: Dean of Graduate and Professional Studies (or designee)

Tenure Restrictions: None

Departmental Restrictions: no more than one (1) from each department

College Restrictions: 2 from CEHS, 2 from CBE, 3 from CAS, 1 at large

Term of Office: 3 years, eligible for reappointment

Method of Selection: appointed by executive committee of faculty senate

Chair: Coordinator of BGS program
