A. A decision was made that as long as the requests are consistent with what EPC and Faculty Senate passed previously, making the changes is appropriate without additional approval.

B. Deadline for curriculum proposals and changes: Discussion was held regarding the possibility of setting a deadline for curriculum proposals and changes in order to have adequate time to review, revise, and approve and for catalog revisions to be made in a timely manner. It was noted that there are already submission dates listed at the bottom of the submission forms: Feb 1 to CCC and March 1 for EPC. Further discussion will be needed.
