Committee on Educational Policy (EPC) Final Report 2021-2022

The voting members of EPC for the 2021-2022 academic year were Sarah Tanner-Anderson (Chair), Amanda Blaisdell (CGPS Curriculum Chair), Jim Haug (CBE Curriculum Chair), Laura Jimenez (CEHS Curriculum Chair), Ben Topham (CCCAS Curriculum Chair), Bill Abrams, Pam McDermott, Ronda Scarrow, Hannah Dudley-Shotwell, Shawn Smith, Corey Call, Erin Wallace, and Tara McDaniel (OTP Representative). Ex-Officio (non-voting) members were David Shoenthal (SACSCOC/SCHEV Liaison), Susan Hines (Registrar), and Kate Morgan (minutes).

The committee sent a total of 214 curriculum proposals to Faculty Senate this year. In addition to the 166 information items, EPC presented 48 approved action items, including 13 new courses, 5 program changes, 7 credit/course changes, 6 new minors, a new graduate track, a new endorsement, and 15 policy changes. Those policy changes included those changes necessary to remove the old general education program from the catalog as well as updating outdated verbiage in graduate policies.

In addition, the committee discussed revisions to the curriculum handbook, reviewed items for Academic Affairs, and assisted colleagues with Curriculog.
