five years. It seems wise to change the curriculum handbook to reflect that. In particular:

## Storage or Deletion or Retrieval of a Course or Program

If a department wishes to remove a course or program from the catalog, it may be sent to storage using the appropriate procedure for course or program change, or deleted permanently. If a course or program is sent to storage, it may be restored to the catalog through a request by the department chair to the Registrar. Courses and/or will remain in storage for seven years before being deleted permanently. The Provost/VPAA Registrar will maintain a list of courses in storage. Once deleted permanently, all paperwork for a new course and/or program would need to be submitted and approved.
