Information Items:

I. **COLLEGE OF ARTS & SCIENCES**

❖ **English & Modern Languages**

1. Course storage: MLAN 301, 451, 452 (no students enrolled)
2. Course storage: ENGL 451, 452 (not been taught recently)
3. Credit hour change: ENGL 482 (to 12 credits to reflect changes in EDUC 488 deletion)
4. Credit hour change: FREN/GERM/SPAN/TESL 482 (to 12 credits to reflect changes in EDUC 488 deletion)
5. Program change: Comparative Literature Concentration (to storage to reflect storage of MLAN 301, 451, 452 above)- **effective fall 2010**
6. Program change: Secondary English Education (to reflect EDUC changes, add an option for 400-level courses, change requirement of a 300- to 400-level English course, remove membership in S-LATE) – **retro 2009-10 catalog**
7. Program change (related): Secondary English Education (requirement to take Praxis II and VCLA) – **retro 2009-10 catalog**
8. Program change: Creative writing concentration (streamline the concentration by altering possible courses and reducing total credit hours by 3) – **retro 2008-09 catalog**
9. Program change: Modern Languages Teaching Endorsement (to reflect EDUC changes, require Praxis II and VCLA, and 482 course change above)
