Current Policy: Suspension or Expulsion from the University

Longwood will suspend or expel any student who fails to meet the standards of the institution and the Student Government Association. A student who is subject to an immediate disciplinary suspension shall receive a grade of "W" in all courses regardless of the time of the semester.

Proposed Policy: Suspension or Expulsion from the University

Longwood will suspend or expel any student who fails to meet the standards of the institution and the Student Government Association. In such a case, refunds may or may not be made at the discretion of the Vice President for Student Affairs. A student who is subject to an immediate disciplinary suspension or expulsion shall receive a grade of "W" in all courses regardless of the time of the semester.

If the expulsion is late enough it is even possible under current policy that an expelled student has an advantage over a suspended student.
