

Facemask Statement

For the 2021-22 academic year, everyone is required to wear a face covering at all times in indoor public settings, including in classrooms and in the hallways, restrooms, and elevators. This policy is contingent on updated CDC guidelines and may change of the course of the semester. The Longwood community will be notified of changes to this policy through e-mail correspondence.

Face coverings must conform to current CDC recommendations (i.e., fabric type and layers), fitting snugly against the side of the face and cover the mouth and nose. Exceptions are possible only in the event that the content of the course is impossible to achieve with a face covering (for example, playing certain musical instruments). Students without appropriate face coverings may be denied entry into the classroom and be counted absent for that day. Faculty and students may report those who refuse to wear a mask to the Office of Student Conduct and Integrity.
