## Honors Advisory Committee Activities: 2007-2008

The Honors Advisory Committee provided support and guidance to the Honors Program in a variety of ways throughout the year. Below please find a summary of key activities and accomplishments.

- 1. The Committee continued its work from the previous academic year and completed the proposal for the Honors College. The proposal was shared with the Longwood community through a faculty forum in the fall semester and through the introduction of the proposal to the Faculty Senate in the spring semester.
- The Committee proposed changes to the academic requirements for the Honors Program. In brief, these changes included the addition of a required study abroad experience and a senior-level research experience. These new program requirements will be in effect for the Fall 2009 incoming class.
- 3. In February, the Committee assisted with an Open House for prospective Honors Program students. As part of that event, members interviewed candidates for Longwood's two largest merit-based scholarships: the Hull Scholars program for future educators and the Cormier Scholars program for other majors. A record number of candidates were interviewed for the Cormier program.
