5	A BILL to amend and reenact § 23-7.4:1 of the Code of Virginia, relating to the partial waiver of
6	tuition for dependent children of university and college faculty in Virginia.

11	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
12	1. That § 23-7.4:1 of the Code of Virginia is amended as follows:
13 14	D. Partial Tuition Waiver for Dependent Children of University and College Faculty.
15	(a) Each year the General Assembly shall allocate funds in the Appropriation Act to provide 50%
16	tuition waivers to the dependent children of faculty members who have been employed full time by any
17	one or more public Virginia colleges or universities for an aggregate period of at least 7 years, and
18	who are currently employed as a full time faculty member in a public Virginia college or university.
19	
20	(b) Tuition waivers shall be used for undergraduate education at any higher education institution
21 22	under the governance or supervision of the State Council of Higher Education.
23	(b) To be eligible to receive a partial tuition waiver, dependent children of eligible faculty of a
24	Virginia college or university (i) must be under the age of 21 at the commencement of the academic
25	year during which the partial tuition waiver is to be effective, (ii) must have been admitted to a
26	Virginia university or college under the same admissions requirements, standards and policies which
27	the admitting university or college applies to all applicants, or (iii) a current student in good standing
28	at a public Virginia university or college.
29	
30	(c) An eligible applicant who has continued to maintain satisfactory academic progress toward
31	graduation may have his or her partial tuition waiver renewed until the time he or she has
32	accumulated tuition waivers for a maximum of 120 undergraduate academic credit hours, or has
33	reached the age of 25, whichever occurs first.

35	(d) No partial tuition waiver offered or allocated to any eligible applicant in accordance with the
36	provisions of this Section shall be charged against any other tuition waiver limitation established by
37	the Commonwealth of Virginia.

39	(e) This partial tuition waiver shall not apply to students enrolled under the academic common
40	market agreement.
41	
42	(f) The State Council of Higher Education shall prescribe procedures, rules and regulations as are
43	necessary to implement and administer the provisions of this Section.
44	DE. Tuition and required fees may be waived for a student from a foreign country enrolled in a public
45	institution of higher education through a student exchange program approved by such institution,
46	provided the number of foreign students does not exceed the number of students paying full tuition and
47	required fees to the institution under the provisions of the exchange program for a given three-year
48	period.
