Virtual Open Forum

The following concerns/suggestions were submitted through the SAC Suggestions Portal on SAC's webpage.

- 1. Service Awards Banquet: Since there was no Service Awards Banquet last year, and it looks as if there won't be one held this year, a list of service award honorees for this year and last year should be published and sent out to faculty/staff. I think everyone would appreciate that. When we eventually return to the banquet, I think a list of the service award recipients still should be sent to faculty/staff. Also, I was surprised that no communication was sent out regarding this. I'm wondering why.
 - a. Human Resources has had to delay the Banquet because of COVID-19 and in the best interest of the community. However, Human Resources has not forgotten about the Banquet, and they are planning for its return in Fall 2022.
- 2. Department: Can we to communicate to all departments that they need to update their websites as soon as possible after staffing changes? People have left Longwood, switched positions to another department, etc. so it's very frustrating to reach out to someone only to find out that they are no longer here or in another area. Also, the email directory is out of date as well. There are people on there that have been long gone from Longwood, and their names are in the directory.
 - a. We encourage anyone who sees a website error to contact the department administrative assistant. Changes can also be requested at requests.longwood.edu. Please note that retirees remain on the website because some elect to maintain their Longwood email.
- 3. Parking: Can we talk with Campus Police about notifying the campus community on a consistent basis when parking spaces are going to be reserved? It's very frustrating to get a parking lot only to find 10 spaces with orange cones. A heads up would be appreciated.
 - a. Parking lot closures are announced via university-wide emails from either Campus Police or via Marketing, Communications, and Engagement. Individual spaces are not reported because of the number of reserved spaces each day/
- 4. Suggestions: I do think that suggestions should be included in the minutes. If it is something that would be of benefit to faculty/staff, I don't see why it would be a secret.
