## Application Guidelines for Faculty Participation in

## **LU-PRISM 2018**

Duration: 8 weeks (May 21 – July 13)

Participants: 12 tenured or tenure-track faculty members participating in STEM-H (Science, Technology,

Engineering, Mathematics, Health) related research; each sponsoring 1 student

Faculty stipend: \$7,000

Student stipend: \$3,500 (+ room and board)

Faculty applicants to LU-PRISM must prepare a summary of their project according to the following guidelines. Proposals will be evaluated based on quality of research, tenure status (pre-tenure having preference over post-tenure), academic area with a goal of having a diverse set of STEM-H disciplines represented in the program, and alignment of student researcher role in the project with LU-PRISM student learning outcomes. Faculty who have not participated in LU-PRISM in previous summers are strongly encouraged to apply. Each faculty member will ideally sponsor one student; however, it may be possible to fund two students. The number of student researchers working with any one faculty member will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis. Ample justification for requesting funding for two students must be provided in the proposal in section III: "Student Researcher Role in the Project".
