We also welcome submission of whole panel sessions on related paper topics – please include above information for all panelists.

**Presentation Format:** Students selected for the conference will be notified by email in late-February. Presenters will need to have access to Zoom to participate in the all-virtual conference.

Conference Fees: Free!

Journal: Students who have been accepted to present at the conference may submit their completed project for publication consideration in our undergraduate journal MadRush Undergraduate Research Journal. A group of faculty referees will select papers for publication.

MadRush Best Paper Prizes/Publication in MadRush Undergraduate Research

The top three papers will receive monetary prizes—1st place: \$100; 2<sup>nd</sup> place: \$75; 3<sup>rd</sup> place: \$50. The submission deadline for publication and prize consideration will be in late February. Winners will be announced at the end of the conference.
