The Network for Undergraduate Research in Virginia (NURVa) is a consortium of Virginia colleges and universities dedicated to supporting undergraduate research and creative activity throughout the state.

The NURVa conference is an opportunity for undergraduates in all disciplines to present their research and creative work at a statewide conference. The 6th annual conference will be held on Saturday, November 1, 2025, on the campus of the University of Mary Washington in Fredericksburg. Faculty mentors are encouraged to attend. Conference registration, which includes continental breakfast and lunch, is \$25. A variety of graduate schools will also be present at the Graduate School Fair. All costs for registration, transportation, and accommodation (if needed) are the responsibility of the student submitter.

NURVa invites submissions from undergraduates in all disciplines in the categories of oral presentation, poster, or performance. Submit abstracts (750 words maximum) with one letter of support from a faculty mentor at https://tinyurl.com/NURVa2025
