#### Welcome/Approval of Minutes

Mr. Copeland welcomed the committee. The minutes of the November 14<sup>th</sup> and October 03<sup>rd</sup> minutes were approved.

#### **Update on Governor's Proposed Budget**

Mr. Copeland advised the committee that he, Brenda Atkins, and Tracy Nelson attended the Governor's proposed budget meeting on December 16<sup>th</sup>. Ken Copeland updated committee members on funding and items proposed in the Governor's budget bill.

President Reveley noted that he has been in Richmond and the Senate is in some turmoil, but evenly split. He feels that based on what he is hearing, Longwood should come out better than last year and that student revenue is the University's overall driver.

Mr. Copeland provided an overview of the expenditure assumptions that will be used in developing the 2014-2015 annual internal budget.

# **Summary of VP Requests**

The committee discussed how Vice Presidential budget requests would be developed and presented. He stated that each Vice President needs to state their case and submit their lists in priority order.

### **Cost Reduction Strategies**

Mr. Copeland asked that all areas examine how they may be able to implement cost reduction strategies in order to curtail charges assessed students. He noted that areas should evaluate and review Employee Work Profiles. When vacancies occur, it is not always beneficial to immediately hire to fill the vacancy. Areas should take a hard look at current positions and ask if "we can do better with what we already have."

Tim Pierson added that Vice Presidents should look at creative ways to structure departments.
