How to use Speedgrader in your Canvas Course This video walks you through using speedgrader within Canvas to be effective and efficient in grading student work.

<u>DEC Webpage Walkthrough</u> In this video you will discover the resources available to you through the DEC's new webpage. They include text-based tutorials, video recordings, and links to outside resources from other sources as well as answers to Frequently Asked Questions.
