DON'T FORGET

As a reminder, May 1st Studio launched as our University wide video platform. As part of this upgrade, Panopto will be going out of service in May 2026.

Important: DEC will not be migrating Panopto content into Canvas Studio. If users have videos they want to keep, they will be required to download them from Panopto and upload them into Canvas Studio before the platform is deactivated in Summer 2026.

As a service to the Longwood community, an integration between **Canvas Studio and Zoom** has been established for new Zoom recordings to automatically migrate to Canvas Studio. This feature is available now! [This guide](#) will help you finalize and customize your integration.

IGNITEAI SUMMARIES FOR DISCUSSIONS

Summaries for Discussions is now available to instructors! Instructors can use this AI feature to view summaries of all posts within a Discussion.

Discussion Summaries can identify key takeaways, themes, and tone within a discussion. This feature is only available to Instructors. Review the Canvas guide [here](#).

This feature has been enabled at the university level, and instructors can choose to activate it for individual courses by following the steps below:

- In Course Navigation, click the **Settings** link.
- Click the **Feature Options** tab.
- Look for **IgniteAI Summaries for Discussions** then click the red X and update to **Enabled**
- Navigate to a course discussion thread and look for the Open Summary button**

LOTI is required to teach hybrid or online courses:

All faculty (including adjunct faculty) who teach an online or hybrid course for Longwood University must successfully complete the LOTI training. All faculty are invited to apply, even if you are not currently scheduled to teach online or hybrid courses. LOTI provides excellent training opportunities to learn about Canvas and course design.

LOTI is for faculty members who:

- are new to the University OR
- have never had online/hybrid training OR
- have never had online/hybrid training and have been asked to teach an existing online/hybrid course OR
- have had previous LOTI training but wish to become online teaching certified through the Longwood training

Spring 2026 LOTI will begin at noon (12pm) on Monday January 26th, 2026 and the final day submissions will be accepted is Friday, March 20th, 2026.

DISCUSSION CHECKPOINTS

[Discussion Checkpoints](#) is a Canvas feature that allows instructors to break a graded discussion into multiple stages, each with its own due date and point value.

This helps manage student engagement by creating distinct deadlines for activities like an initial post and subsequent replies to peers.

Checkpoints provide clearer expectations for students and allow instructors to grade each stage separately, improving structure and feedback for both.

This feature was turned on December 15, 2025.
