Who will be surveyed?	All part-time and full-time, degree-seeking, undergraduate students enrolled during the fall 2020 semester will be surveyed. Participation in the NSSE Pulse must be presented as voluntary and student participation incentives are not permitted due to the brevity of the survey. Faculty are asked to encourage the completion of the NSSE Pulse using the link that students have received within their email invitation and reminders.
When and how will the NSSE Pulse be administered? What type of results does LU receive?	Basic summary reports for each participating institution and comparative group results in the aggregate will be provided by NSSE at close of the fall semester. None of the results will be individually identifiable. <i>Onie McKenzie</i> , the Assistant Vice President for Student Affairs, will prepare summary reports and presentations that will be shared with various campus stake holders.
