I. Information items

A. College of Education and Human Services (Dept of Social Work and Communication Sciences and Disorders)

1. Communication Sciences and Disorders program
  - a. CDDS 313 – change in pre-requisite
2. Social Work program
  - a. SOWK 492 – change in pre-requisites
  - b. Program change
    - 1) Account for removal of Goal 12
    - 2) Increase SOWK electives from 15 to 18 credits
    - 3) Show previous course change to SOWK 492
    - 4) Change in gate requirements

B. College of Arts & Sciences

1. Department of Communication Studies and Theatre
  - a. New course: COMM 320 – Communicating for Diverse Audiences
2. Department of Psychology
  - a. Psychology minor program change: Add minimum grade requirement for psychology courses

2. Program changes:
  - a. BS in Economics –

    - 2) Add ECON 319 to core requirements
    - 3) Remove three credits of electives
    - 4) Add ENGL 319
    - 5) Change CIMS to MISA
  - b. BSBA
    - 1) Accounting concentration – increase number of required courses selected from concentration group from 3 to 4
    - 2) Economics concentration – Add ENGL 319 & remove 3 credits of electives
    - 3) Degree program changes
      - i. Reduce total number of credit hours for Business Ed concentration
      - ii. Remove MISA 170 from core
      - iii. Add 3 credits to electives
      - iv. Account for General Education change
      - v. Increase minimum credits for internship from 1 to 2
