3) Report on the number of cases it has heard to the Senate and to a meeting of the general faculty at least once a year.


types of grievances: FFPM VI.N.

The grievance involves any issue affecting faculty status including (but not limited to the following):

- (1) Tenure
- (2) Contract renewal
- (3) Promotion
- (4) Salary (limited to due process)
- (5) Merit increases (limited to due process)
- (6) Academic freedom
- (7) Unethical conduct
- (8) Other general areas
