GRADUATE CURRICULUM COMMITTEE

- 1. Purpose and Duties: The Graduate Curriculum Committee reviews proposals for new and revised graduate courses and graduate degree programs and makes recommendations to the Graduate Council and the Committee on Educational Policy.
- **2. Membership:** Varies with the number of graduate degree programs. Members shall consist of the Graduate Program Coordinators or their designee in the event they are the elected Graduate Council member.
 - **3. Ex-Officio Members:** The Dean of the College of Graduate and Professional Studies and the Assistant Dean(s). (Non-voting, except to break a tie vote.)
 - 4. Tenure Restrictions: None.
 - 5. Departmental Restrictions: None.
 - 6. College Restrictions: None.
 - **7. Other Restrictions:** Committee members must be current graduate faculty.
 - **8. Term of Office:** May vary depending on the terms of office for Program Coordinators.
 - **9. Method of Selection:** Each Program Coordinator is appointed by the Chair of the department responsible for the program (following departmental bylaws).
 - **10.** Chair: Elected by the Graduate Council at the first fall meeting.
 - 11. Reporting Route: To the Graduate Council and the Committee on Educational Policy.
