## NSSE 2014 Items of Interest to Faculty: Response Frequencies and Mean Comparisons

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With a higher than expected response rate of 47%, 812 Longwood students (439 freshmen/373 seniors) completed the 2014 National Survey of Student Engagement. The following tables compare the response frequencies and mean comparisons of the first-year and senior students from Longwood and the 108 comparable South East Public Institutions on the individual items that were deemed of particular interest to faculty.

The percentages that follow represent a *weighted* percentage of students responding to each question adjusted for Longwood's sex and enrollment status. The selected items are in the same order and wording as they appeared on the 2014 NSSE. Items with mean differences that are larger than would be expected by chance are noted with asterisks referring to three significance levels (\*p<.05, \*\*p<.01, \*\*\*p<.001). Green shading notes a mean comparison to Longwood's favor; red shading indicates a deficit. The magnitude of the effect size is noted by the strength (brilliance) of the shading. The Darkest Green shading reveals a positive statistically significant difference greater than (p<.05) with an effect size at least .3 in magnitude. The Darkest Red shading reveals a negative statistically significant difference greater than (p<.05) with an effect size at least .3 in magnitude.
