TOPIC: Undergraduate Graduation Policy

At its January 22 meeting, Faculty Senate passed a change to the Undergraduate Graduation Policy. The revised policy states:

"Students who are in good academic standing with the university, have seven (7) or fewer academic credits or one course remaining for the completion of their degree, and have enrolled in the courses required for graduation for the subsequent summer and/or fall academic semesters shall be permitted to participate in the graduation ceremony. Those students who have seven (7) credit hours or fewer or one course remaining to complete their degree must also receive approval from their department chair and the registrar in order to participate in the graduation ceremony. Diplomas will be mailed to students normally within eight weeks of commencement or the completion of their degree requirements."

RATIONALE FOR THE POLICY OR PROPOSED CHANGES (Provide a brief statement as to why the new policy, the changes, or the deletion is needed):

After passage of the policy by Senate, the registrar, Provost, and department chairs were consulted about the role of the department chairs in the policy. The Academic Chairs Council voted in support of removing department chairs' approval from the policy. The registrar and Provost agreed that this is a clear-cut issue as to whether students qualify to walk at graduation; department chairs are not needed to verify students' academic record or registration for summer or fall courses. Any exceptions to this policy will be considered first by the registrar, who will refer the case to the appropriate Dean's office, and then if necessary, to the Provost/VPAA's office.
