


# What did faculty and students want from a new Core Curriculum?

- Continued opportunities to explore potential majors
- Additional academic support for students
- Elimination of hidden prerequisite courses
- Clear connections between courses within the Core Curriculum
- Clear connections between the Core Curriculum and major and minor programs
- Stronger emphasis on written communication skills
- More opportunities for faculty collaboration and room for faculty creativity



# Here's what we designed with on-going input from faculty





## Student Support

- First-year courses focus on writing and speaking
- Courses throughout program are Writinginfused or Speaking-infused
- Pillar courses emphasize academic support specific to discipline
- Citizenship topics and Pillar courses allow exploration of majors

#### Flexibility for Majors

- Students may count up to 2 Pillar courses towards each major and minor
- Students may count 1 Perspectives course towards each major and minor
- Majors may offer courses in up to 2 Pillars
- Writing and speaking intensive courses no longer required in a major
- Internships requirements decided by major



Historical and Contemporary OR Behavioral and Social Perspective courses must be Speaking-infused	Historical and Contemporary OR Behavioral and Social Perspective courses may be Speaking- or Writing- infused
Global or Aesthetic Perspectives courses must be Writing-infused	Global or Aesthetic Perspectives courses may be Speaking- or Writing-infused



## Changes since August

At August Workshop	Change after August Workshop
Quantitative OR Scientific Perspective courses must be Speaking-infused	Quantitative OR Scientific Perspective courses may be Speaking- or Writing-infused
Arts-infused	Arts-applied
If arts-infused, activities must constitute at least 15% of Foundation level courses and 10% of Perspectives courses	If arts-applied, activities must constitute at least 50% of Foundation level courses and 50% of Perspectives courses
